AUDITION SCENE 3, YOUNGER STUDENTS K-2

*NOTE: SYDNEY IS A SPIDER (BOY OR A GIRL) BETH IS A BAT.*

BETH- Hey Sydney.

SYDNEY- Hey Beth.

BETH- Why do you look so sad?

SYDNEY- Halloween is coming up, and I haven't been able to scare anyone.

BETH- Ooo. That's no good.

SYDNEY- What's the point of being a Creepy Critter if I can't make anyone scream in terror?

SYDNEY- Boo?
