

## Student Behavior Policies

To assure that our environment stays safe and fun for our campers, we have rules and policies.

Our rules:

1. Please don't speak while the director is speaking.
2. Eating is not allowed outside of snack time. We take snack break two hours into the camp.
3. Stay in the designated rehearsal space. Children may not leave the room and especially the building without first asking for permission. We take restroom breaks every hour.
4. Don't touch anything that doesn't belong to you, including other people.
5. Drama is not a playground. There is no running, jumping, **chasing**, hitting, throwing, catching, kicking, climbing, swinging, or crawling of any type unless it is specifically part of their performance. This rule is VERY important to the physical safety of the students.

We have the right and responsibility to remove any student for breaking these rules. We are very reasonable when it comes to rules 1, 2, and 4, and will typically just remind the students to refrain from this behavior. Rules 3 and 5 are the most important though, and based on the severity of the infraction, we will immediately remove the child from the camp and call a parent to come collect them. No refunds will be offered if a child is removed from the camp for behavior issues.

Please share these rules with your child before bringing them to camp.

### SNACKS

We take a 15 minute snack break two hours into each camp. There is no refrigerator or microwave available for the students, so please keep that in mind while packing. We ask that you not send any peanut butter or shellfish to camp with your child for snacks, as we always have students that have severe allergies.

### CLOTHING

We ask the students come dressed in comfortable clothes that they can dance in. Shorts and a tee shirt are fine. Skirts and dresses are probably not a good idea. In addition, because of the dancing involved in our songs, students should not wear flip flops, crocs, sandals, or boots. Tennis shoes/sneakers are fine. Dance shoes are encouraged.
